INSTITUTE OBJECTIVES

- Identify equity implications of current disaggregated program enrollment and completion data.
- Develop an internal communications plan to share program data with internal stakeholders, including the best framing for the institutional implications of the program data and the next steps for making changes.
- Setting the stage for how to engage community partners in the conversation about community college programs, alignment with the workforce, gaps that exist, and how to collaborate to address those gaps.
