- Award associate degrees, diplomas, and certificates in more than 40 areas










FOUR PILLARS OF GUIDED PATHWAYS

- Guided Pathway work started in fall 2020
- Task Force leads our college-wide effort
- Collaborative approach (faculty, staff, students, administration, community and high school partners)
- Set goals, identify lead, and move forward
- Continuous communication
- Continuous professional development







BCTC Career Pathways Highlights



CLARIFY & ENTER THE PATH

- Created 7 career pathways
 - Analyzed first semester success data to develop first semester plan for each pathway
 - Light your fire course during first semester
- Launched <u>career pathways website</u>
- Professional staff advisors and students assigned to career pathways
- Incorporated a new career pathways session into first year orientations (summer 2022) and revamped orientation (summer 2023)
- Implemented MyMajors (career assessment tool) (fall 2022)
- Implemented "Hi" Five Questions (fall 2022)





BCTC Career Pathways Highlights

STAY ON THE PATH & ENSURE LEARNING

- Using mid-term grades and Starfish to support student success
- Targeted outreach campaigns
 - Call campaigns, text messages, advisor outreach, emails
- Spotlight Instruction Series to improve learning in high impact, low success courses
- Relaunched Teaching and Learning Center (August 2022)
 - Workgroup focused on developing a plan for Teaching and Learning Center Relaunch used <u>Achieving the Dream Teaching and Learning Toolkit</u>
 - Created team of support
 - Teaching and Learning Center Director (Fall 2023)
- Increased embedded tutoring and 24/7 tutoring opportunities
- Strengthened and restructured program health reviews (assessment)

- PD opportunities focused on guided pathways
- Created new positions to support underrepresented populations and student success

- Director of Adult Student Support (Summer 2023)





Ask

Engage students in ongoing conversation about their interest, strengths, and aspirations.



Connect

Provide opportunities for connections with faculty, peers, alumni, and employers in field of interest.



Inspire

Every student takes a "light the fire" course in their first semester.



Plan

Every student has a fully developed educational plan to monitor progress.





"Hi" Five Questions



New Student

- What excites you about your Academic Program/Career Pathway and attending college?
- What are your educational and career goals?
- What do you like to learn about and how do you like to learn? (modality)
- What are your obligations outside of school?
- Have you submitted all your required Official Transcripts (High School/Dual Credit/Transfer),
 ACT/Placement Scores, and FAFSA?

Continuing Student

- How are your current classes going?
 How did your last semester go?
- Are you happy with your current Academic Program/Career Pathway?
- What is one highlight, event or person that impacted your semester positively?
- How do you feel about where you are today and your educational/career progress?
- Have you reviewed your degree audit with your Advisor lately? Do you have any holds? Do you know which classes you need to graduate?









Spring 2023 and Fall 2023

- Redesigned First Year Orientation (March 1, 2023)
- Developed <u>career pathway learning</u> <u>communities</u> for fall 2023 enrollment
- Developed <u>Fayette County High School</u> pathways (partnership with FCPS) and added to <u>career pathways website</u>
- Each student will have a complete educational plan posted in PeopleSoft notes (started in summer 2023)
- Develop plan for data analysis (fall 2023)



Lessons Learned....Advice For Moving Forward

- Buy in (starts with administration)
- College-wide effort
- Don't be afraid to try something
 - It is okay if it doesn't work
- Learn from others and tweak to fit your student needs
- Every student matters
- Focus on closing equity gaps
- Keep momentum going
 - Develop team and meet regularly to check in on progress
