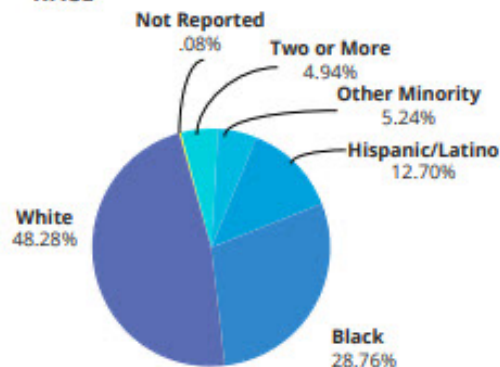

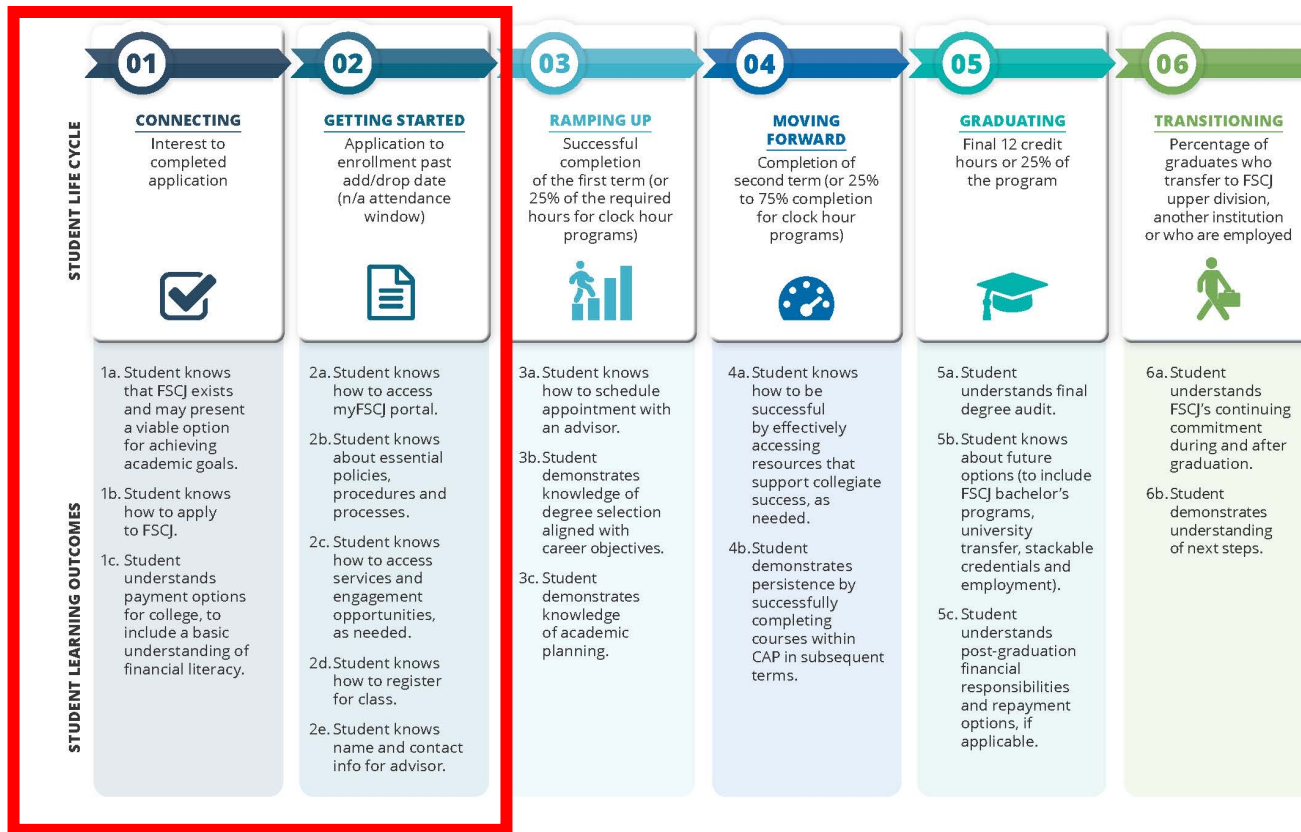

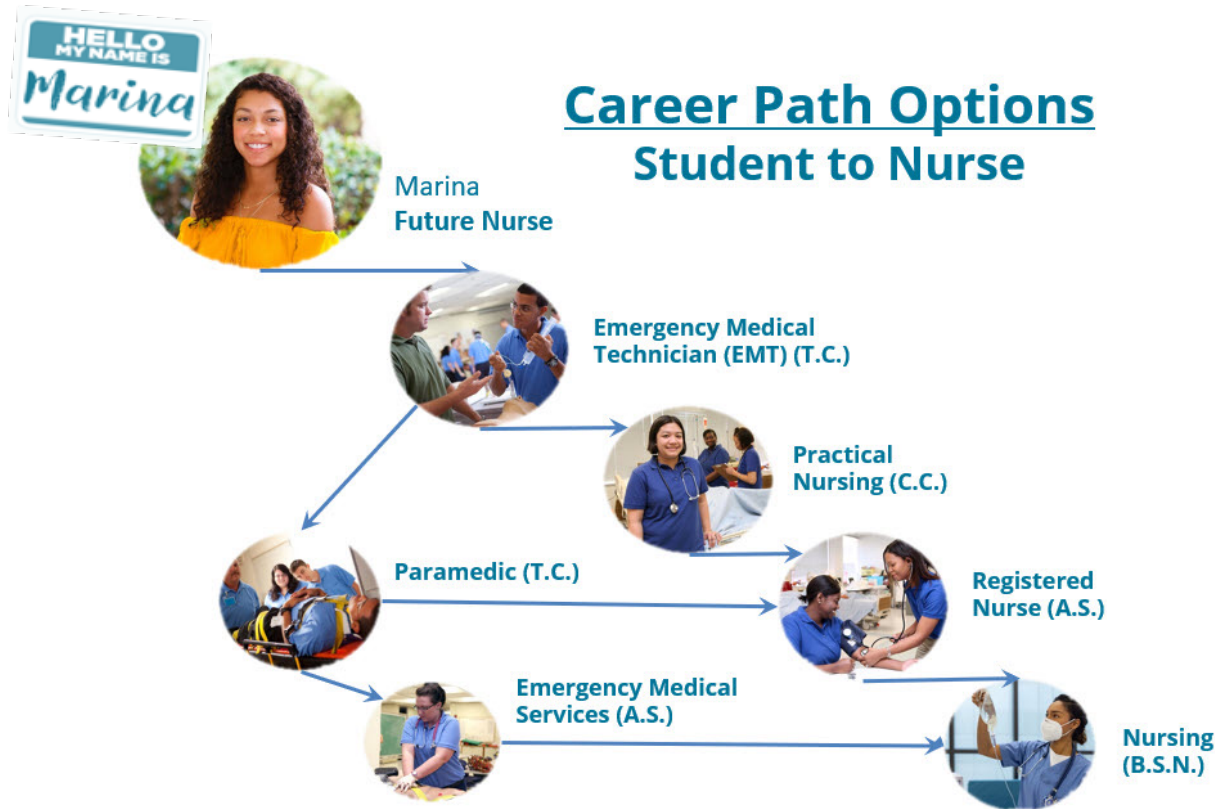


SOURCES OF AID

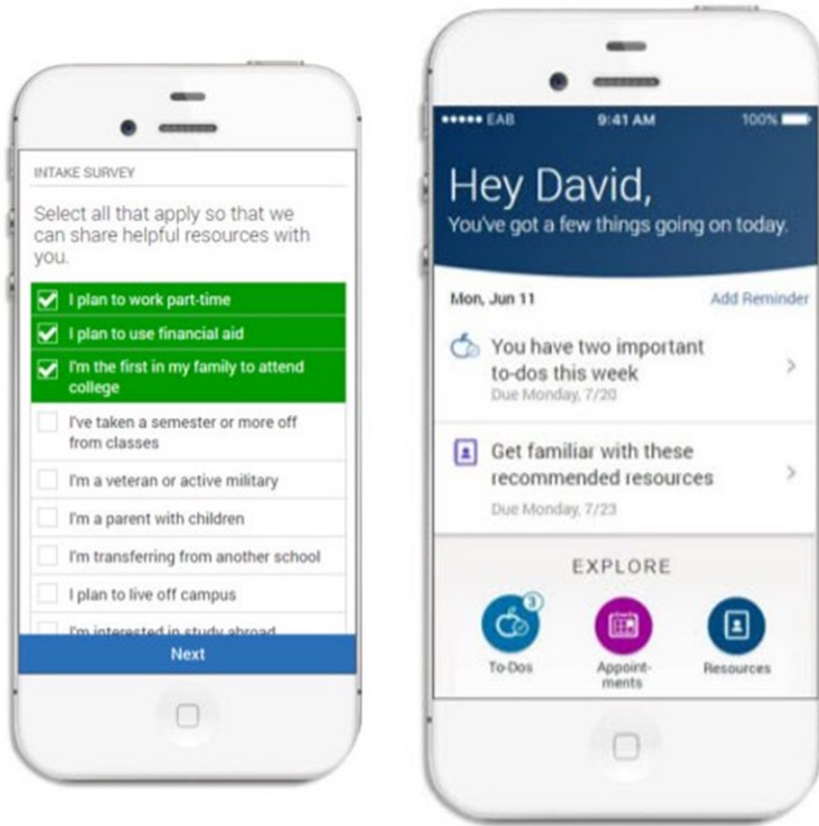

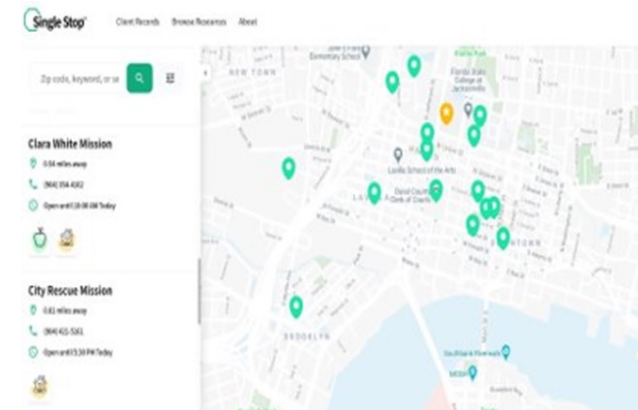
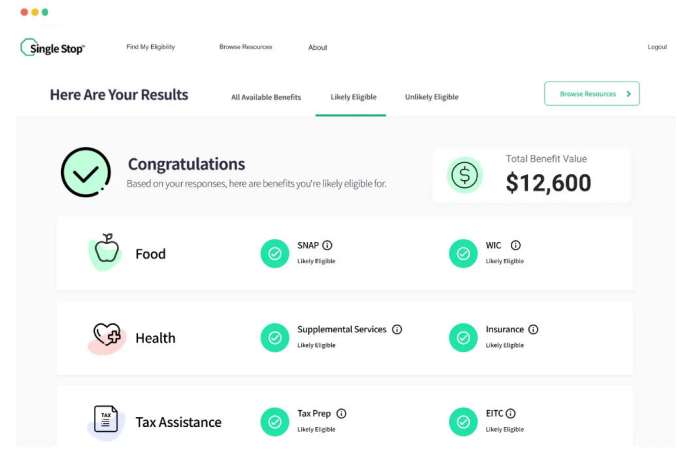
